Large-leaved rhododendrons in assorted sizes and varieties.

CAPISTRANO	Hardest yellow rhododendron -25F available June \$30
CRETE	Indumented semidwarf with pink to white bloom. Z6 \$12
FANTASTICA	Red with good dense plant form and glossy foliage Z6 \$12
INGRID MEHLQUIST	Very floriferous Yak x, precocious later season bloomer, large truss of 20+ pink buds go pure white, light indumentum -25F \$8
PERCY WISEMAN	Full bushy plant with peachy orange-pink bloom. -15F 3 gal \$30
PINK PARASOL	Dark pink buds open pink and attractive leaves have heavy indumentum and attractive new growth -20F \$25 available June
SKOOKUM	Bright red late bloom on compact 4'X4' shrub, buds freely in 2nd year -25F \$8
WOJNER'S PURPLE	Late dark purple bloom. -15F \$12

Small-leaved rhododendrons generally bloom earlier, are hardier than large leaf rhodos and can tolerate more sun. Their leaves and twigs are fragrant when crushed. Most have attractive fall-winter foliage colour of red, purple or golden orange. They are reliable bloomers and their April flowers make them cheerful, welcome additions to the garden. APRIL MIST	Beautiful double blooms of soft pink-white edged in light mauve on a compact plant with attractive foliage. Striking. Grows to 5' X 4' -20F \$8 up

APRIL ROSE	This plant produces an early spring shower of bright rose-pink double flowers on a background of dark mahogany red foliage. It is an upright grower to 5' X 4'. It needs good drainage. -20F \$8 up
BLUE BARON	Blue-mauve flower, compact hardy plant, lovely bronze winter foliage -15F \$12
EVENING SKY	(Blue Diamond x R.carolinianum) flowers deep violet fade to blue -15F \$12 up
IMPEDITUM	Chinese species tiny-leaved 1'X3' mound covered early in purple bloom -15 \$25
ISOLA BELLA	Salmon buds open yellow and white on exceptional foliage plant -15F \$8
LANDMARK	Cherry red bloom, robust 4'X3' plant, mahogany bronze winter colour -25F \$25
MIDNIGHT RUBY	Dwarfer growth, red bloom, deep purple winter foliage. -25F \$12 MILESTONE (dauricum x minus) dark pink blooms on a bushy semi-deciduous plant--20F

AZALEAS

DECIDUOUS AZALEAS	grow well in full sun and flower on young plants. Many are fragrant, have excellent fall foliage and the range of bloom colour extends to warm oranges and yellows.
ARNESON LITTLE GEM	Prolific June bloom, red buds open soft yellow-orange edged red on a more compact growing plant 3'X4' -20F \$8
CHEERFUL GIANT	Balls of double yellow blooms with orange blotch, mid-late 5'X4' -20F \$8
FRED GALLE	Warm yellow late season bloom into Aug on 6'X4' plant \$8
LEMON DROP	Fragrant yellow July bloom, burgundy fall leaf, vigorous 4'X4' plant, -25F \$12
MILLENIUM	Fragrant deep red flower with orange flare, strong mildew resistant blue green foliage, late 3'X2 1/2' -15F \$12
MY MARY	Early butter yellow bloom on dark green-leaved well-branched 3'X4' plant \$8
SCHLIPPENBACHIA	This is one of the best performing deciduous azaleas. Flat-faced usually pink blooms appear on bare stems early in Spring and the leaves provide spectacular fall colour in tones of orange, red and burgundy on this very hardy species. -25F \$8
EVERGREEN AZALEAS	These are very pruneable heavy bloomers for part shade or shade. Protect from wind.
GIRARD'S PLEASANT WHITE	Large late white blooms brushed with cream sparkle on dark green compact 3'X3' plant,-15F \$20
ROSEBUD	Double pink 1" rose-like blooms on dense 3'X3' plant Z6 \$20

KALMIA

Mountain laurel or kalmia are beautiful, hardy, native evergreen shrubs that extend the blooming time into late June. They bloom heaviest in sandier sunnier conditions at the edge of woods. Planting with decayed pine-bark or needles, peat and a sprinkling of pelletized sulphur can be helpful as they like acidic well-draining soil. They should be protected from drying winter winds. -20F Limited numbers of other varieties in larger sizes for pickup only.

CAROL	One of best foliage plants with big glossy wavy leaves, deep pink bud opens pink. \$12
HEART OF FIRE	Red buds open wide to a big pale pink flower on plant of vigorous upright growth \$12
KEEPSAKE	Raspberry red in bud opening almost solid burgundy with white edge, outstanding foliage, American Nurseryman Plant of the Year in '98 \$12
LITTLE LINDA	Miniature with 1/2-sized leaf, dense well-branched habit, red bud opens pink \$12
MADELINE	Only true double, rosy bud opens white with a few wine speckles, dense glossy foliage on upright plant to 8' \$35
PRISTINE	Chosen from S. Carolina woods for its abundant white bloom, diminutive extra thick leaf is drought and heat resistant but also cold hardy. Compact 3'X3' plant. \$30
SNOWDRIFT	White flowers on outstanding densely branched dark foliage plant \$8
TINKERBELL	Similar to Tiddlywinks but is a more vigorous semi-dwarf that grows wider than tall with medium pink heavier textured bloom. \$12

CALLICARPA BODINIERI PROFUSION	Japanese Beautyberry has pink spirea-like blooms, profusion of purple berries form in late summer that last through winter, grows to 6' if not pruned. Need 2 for cross pollination. Z6 \$12
CEPHALANTHUS OCCIDENTALIS	Buttonbush is a native that grows in wet shade or dry sun, tropical fragrant spherical white blooms June-August, great red and gold fall colour. -20F \$20+ 4 year plants
CLETHRA BARBINERVIS	Beautiful Japanese shrub with fragrant small white flowers borne in panicles in late summer, bark smooth and exfoliating to reveal tones of lavender, grey, cream -20F \$8
C. ALNIFOLIA RUBY SPICE	Fragrant pink flowers in summer on this native stoloniferous shrub that tolerates deeply shady wet or dry areas, ideal for borders, walkways and problem areas. -40F \$15
CLEMATIS 'BLUE JASMINE'	Native vine blooms most of summer in dry sun or moist shade with fragrant blue bells. Z5 \$12
CORYLOPSIS SPICATA	Close relative of witchhazel has pendulous fragrant yellow blooms in early spring. -20F \$15

DAPHNE MEZEREUM	This is a late-winter flowering shrub with a rounded habit. A slow grower to 4', heavily fragrant mauve blooms become bright red berries in early summer. For a well-drained site. -20F \$7-12
DECAISNEA FARGESII	A collector's plant, Blue Bean is a tropical appearing bush with blue-green leaves and metallic blue 4" pods that follow foot long yellowy flower panicles in June. Plant 2 for fruit set. Like Rhododendrons needs moist acid shade. Dieback perennial shrub in Z 6. 2@\$25
DISANTHUS CERCIDIFOLIUM	Stunning burgundy and gold fall colour on heart-shaped redbud-like leaves, maroon witch hazel-like bloom in fall too, attractive rarely offered Asian specimen grows into 6'-10' shrubby tree \$25
ENKIANTHUS CAMPANULATUS	A companion plant for rhododendrons, late spring blooms are pendant clusters of cream-coloured bells with red accents. The leaves turn brilliant red in fall. 8'X5' -20F
ENKIANTHUS C. MIYAMABENI	This plant is faster growing and has reddish-pink flowers on red stems. \$18
ENKIANTHUS C. 'RED BELLS'	Creamy bells rimmed red, beautiful tiered growth, outstanding orange-red-yellow fall colour. Slower, wider growth 6'X6' \$35 available June
ENKIANTHUS C. 'SHOWY LANTERN'	Cherry red flowers, red orange autumn leaves. 8'X5' \$35 available June
ENKIANTHUS C. VAR. SIKOKIANUS	Rich burgundy buds open to red bells streaked with pink. 8'X5' \$35
FOTHERGILLA MOUNT AIRY	A vigorous upright grower to 5', selected as outstanding by Dirr. Fragrant white bottlebrush blooms in terminal spikes appear before leaves. Excellent orange red fall colour -20F \$18

Maryland Beauty	A deciduous holly with compact form and large dark red berries
Southern Gentleman	male pollinator , white flowers but fruitless
Winter Red and Wintergold	heavy fruiting varieties; all native hollies are hardy to -40 F \$8-\$15
LINDERA BENZOIN	The native spicebush, an understory shrub is well adapted to wet areas but does well in other situations. Host plant of swallowtail butterflies. Small yellow flowers along the stems in early spring turn to brilliant red drupes in fall that are prized by migrating birds. -30F \$12
HYDRANGEA 'GEOFFREY CHADBUND'	Terracotta red lacecap bloom on 5-6' plant Z6 \$10
H. MACROPHYLLA 'NIGRA'	Dark purple stems attractive contrast with light green foliage on vigorous 6'X6' plant, mauve to pink bloom depending on soil pH Z6 \$8 available June
H. QUERCIFOLIA 'LITTLE HONEY'	Sport of Pee Wee, dwarf of native oakleaf, has golden foliage, red brown stems, 6" white bloom, and scarlet fall colour. Best yellow leaf colour if protected from afternoon sun. 3'X3' Z6 \$15

H. Q. 'SNOWFLAKE	Very floriferous double-flowered form of native oakleaf hydrangea. Z6 \$15
H. serrata 'Preziosa'	Outstanding fall colour of burgundy, red and gold, spring leaves and stems purple, each mophead a mix of cream, pink and red, compact 3-4' plant Z6 \$15
Leucothoe 'Scarletta Zebliid'	Scarlet Pillar forms narrow dense 2' high column of foliage that is burgundy red in winter, new leaves in spring and summer are bright scarlet. Z5 \$12
Lonicera 'Harlequin'	pink, white, green leaved honeysuckle vine can be kept pruned as 2' shrub; pink ,yellow and white fragrant bloom Z5 \$15
Parrotia persica	This outstanding ornamental develops multicoloured exfoliating bark with age. A late winter blooming cousin of witch hazel it sports red bloom and outstanding purple-orange-red fall colour, new leaves are plum then edged maroon. -20F 1-2' \$25
Pieris japonica 'Flaming Silver'	Silver-edged foliage stunning in spring with cherry pink new growth, early white flowers, needs shade, a compact 4'X5' Z6 \$18
P. j. 'Sarabande'	white bloom on light green foliage, vigorous late-blooming compact shrub. Z6 \$18
Schizophragma h. 'Moonlight'	Japanese hydrangea vine has silvery grey foliage and 10" bloom. For sun or shade. Z6 \$10
Vaccinium 'Top hat'	Dwarf blueberry chosen for outstanding scarlet fall colour. Z5 \$8
Viburnum x burkwoodii 'Mohawk'	Vigorous compact 7' shrub prunes well, showy orange-red fall colour, abundant shiny red buds last weeks, open to very fragrant white bloom with red exterior, red fruit (sets with Conoy) Z6 \$18
V. utile 'Conoy'	Evergreen with lustrous deep green foliage gets dark maroon winter colour, dense 4'X5' shrub, pink-white lightly scented bloom, for part shade out of wind, E or N exposure like rhodos, US Nat'l Arboretum selection hardy in Ithaca (plant with Mohawk to set dusky purple fruit) Z6 \$18
V. nudum 'Winterthur'	Outstanding form of smooth witherod, lustrous leaves turn purply red in fall, flowers are creamy flat-topped cymes of 5"dm. The fruit changes from green to pink, red, blue before becoming black in September, all colours present in the same cluster. Must plant 2 for fruit set. -20F \$20
V. rufidulum	Rusty Blackhaw is a choice native sporting dark blue fruits covered in brown hair on a 12-15' shrub with leathery dark green leaves and white flowers. Rich maroon fall colour. Z6 \$10

Ornamental Trees

Acer buergerianum	Trident maple, open tree to 25m in wilds of China, goes scarlet-olive in fall, then orange. Z6 \$10
Acer capillipes	Japanese snakebark maple has reddish green bark striped white and coral-red new growth plus crimson to dark red fall colour. A good tree for a shade garden. -20F \$18
Acer circinatum	Vinemaple is a smaller understory tree with brilliant red, orange, yellow fall colour. Z4 \$25+
Acer davidii	Chinese striped-bark maple has reddish green bark boldly striped white and golden orange fall foliage. -25F \$25
Acer japonicum 'Attaryi'	Attractive shrub-tree selection of Vertrees, 12m in 50 years, nodding red flower clusters, has striking orange/scarlet autumn foliage. Z5 2-3' \$50
Acer japonicum 'O isami'	Outstanding treelike shrub, 10mX10m in 100 years, gives spectacular scarlet, gold, orange and green fall display. Z5 2-3' \$45
Acer pseudosieboldianum	The outstanding features of this small Korean Maple with deeply dissected leaves are its extreme cold-hardiness and brilliant yellow, red and orange fall colour. The seed source survived -40F making it a good alternative to "Japanese" maples. Pickup only \$20
Acer Sterculiaceum ssp. Franchettii	From China this rarely planted midlevel maple prefers acid soil. New leaves are bluish purple and covered in downy hairs, red in fall. The large rounded leaves are quite distinct. -20F \$25
Acer triflorum	Dense tree can grow to 10m, trifoliolate leaves go a brilliant gold with red speckles in fall, beige bark peels in tight vertical curls. Favourite of nurseries in N.China and Korea. -30F 2-3' \$35
Acer truncatum	This smaller growing maple is resistant to drought and air pollution. Young leaves have a purplish overtone turning olive green with purple margins. -20F \$35
Amel. x grandiflora Autumn Brilliance	Fast growing heavily branched tree to 25'. \$20
Amel. x 'Cole's Select'	Thick glossy leaf purple in spring, red in fall, buds purple. Upright 20'X15' in time. 4' \$40
Amel. x 'Princess Diana'	Abundant pure white bloom, 3/8" berry, glowing red fall colour, great leafspot resistance. 3' \$35
Amel. x 'Prince William'	Large bloom and fruit on compact, suckering shrub 8'X10', pure white bloom starts in 2nd year, twiggy growth ideal for hedge or fence, orangey red autumn display \$8
Betula davurica	Northern Chinese native birch has bark that peels in tight flakes in colours including cream, pink, cinnamon and shades of grey, is unaffected by leaf miner, tolerates shallow dry soils. -20F \$35
Betula nigra 'Heritage'	North American birch selected for its outstanding pink, cinnamon, gold peeling bark, hardiness, borer resistance and ability to grow in waterlogged or dry soils. -40F \$10-50

Betula x 'Royal Frost'	Royal purple leaves and pure white bark make this tree for sun a knockout specimen. \$12
Carpinus coreana	Korean hornbeam is rarely seen in landscapes here but is a choice small ornamental specimen tree that is strong and drought resistant. Tiny leaves, tight internodes make it ideal for bonsai. Z6 \$10
C. japonica	Rapidly grows to rounded 25' tree. Disease and pest free, leaves remarkable for 3-D deeply embossed look, decorated with 'hops' chains in summer and fall. Z6 2-3' \$15
C. laxiflora	Looseflower hornbeam is a hard to find beauty. Drooping branches are adorned with long chains of bright pink keys that are longer lasting than flowers but just as showy. Tree will develop striking patterned bark. Excellent branching makes it terrific for bonsai. Z6 2-3' \$20
Carya laciniosa	Shellbark hickory is a handsome hardy native tree to 60' with shaggy bark and sweet tasting nutmeat that can grow in wetlands as well as drier meadows or lawns. Z6 \$7
Cercidiphyllum japonicum	The Katsura is a delightful 3-season tree with plum coloured new leaves, warm gold tones in fall with caramel apple scent to leaves. \$9
Cercis Chinensis 'Avondale'	A small tree or large shrub blooming slightly ahead of C. Canadensis in April, and more showy according to Dirr. Avondale produces a profusion of deep rose-purple flowers. -10F \$25
Chionanthus virginicus	The fringe tree is a beautiful native with fleecy white panicles, blue fruits on females -30F \$14-45
Chitalpa tashkenensis 'Morning cloud'	Hybrid of desert willow and native catalpa is a drought resistant shrubby tree 6-10' for sun. White orchid-like blooms on new growth in July, no pods, dies back to the ground in Zone 5. -15F \$15
C. t. 'Pink Dawn'	Showy pink flowers similar to Catalpa but without messy seed pods \$10
Cladrastis kentukea	American Yellowwood is a native rare to cultivation noted for fragrant wisteria-like white with yellow eye summer flower clusters and roots that yield yellow dye. Quick grower for sun. Z5 \$12
Cornus florida	Native flowering dogwood. \$8
Cornus kousa 'Gold Star'	Slower growing tree in sun or shade, each leaf has strong gold center, bracts white. Z5 2' \$50
Cornus kousa Satomi	Strong upright grower flowers in a rich variety of muted pinks with maroon tinted leaves. Z5 \$45
Cornus kousa. var. chinensis	More vigorous, earlier flowering, sweeter fruited, purpler fall colour than Japanese Kousa. 30'X30' in 50 years. Z4 1' \$8
Cornus kousa 'Wolf Eyes'	One of the best variegated forms, white-edged leaves brighten shady spot but also withstand sun. Shrubby dwarf grows wider than tall, 5'X7' in 6 years. Z5 2' \$50

Cornus officianalis	Japanese dogwood has yellow flowers in early spring and showy rich marbled brown, grey and orange coloured bark. -30F pickup only 6-8' \$55
Cotinus obovatus	The American Smokebush is a native large upright shrub-tree with a stunning intensity of fall colour. Rarely offered, it thrives in rocky dry sunny areas. -20F \$20
Diospyros virginiana	American Persimmon is a tough smaller tree with deeply furrowed bark, fruit attracts wildlife, good for naturalizing. -15F \$12
Fagus sylvatica v. purpurea	Purple-leaved European beech is a slow growing but magnificent tree. Z6 1' \$8
Franklinia alatamaha	Rare Carolinian native, camellia-like creamy autumn bloom atop brilliant reddish fall foliage. \$25+
H. tetraptera	Carolina Silverbell is a vigorous full-sized understory tree that blooms in spring. Z5 \$8
H. t. 'Arnold Pink'	Pink flowered form of above. \$20
Heptacodium miconoides	Introduced from China in 1980, this multi-stemmed small tree bears small white flowers in panicles in late summer followed by dark red-purple calyces. The exfoliating bark is another attractive feature. -10F \$15
Metasequoia glyptostroboides	The "Dawn Redwood" was discovered as a "living fossil" in China in 1941, a deciduous conifer of vigorous upright habit with soft reddish brown bark exfoliating in long strips. -10F \$15
Oxydendron arboreum	A slow growing, acid loving specimen tree for sun has hanging panicles of white flowers in summer that persist changing to yellow then brown in contrast with the leaves. Yellow, red and orange fall colours and richly textured bark make this a four season tree. -20F \$20
Pterostyrax Hispida	The fragrant epaulette is a small tree, white blooms hang in 10" panicles in late spring. -30F \$25
Robinia pseudoacacia 'Frisia'	This Black Locust boasts brilliant yellow spring foliage that fades chartreuse in summer. Vigorous, nitrogen fixing tree has fragrant clusters of white pea-like bloom in June. Z5 6' \$45
R. ps. 'Purple Robe'	Black Locust with red bronze leaf colour, fragrant chains of purplish pink bloom, forms small rounded tree to 30', denser with pruning. 3-4' \$35
Stewartia pseudocamellia	One of the most desirable small landscape trees it has white camellia-like flowers in June, red gold fall colour and bark that develops striking pastel patches for winter interest. -15F \$25 and \$45
Styrax japonicus	Graceful little tree with dainty opposite leaves perched upon branches like butterflies, has profuse white 3/4" bell-shaped flowers in June that are best seen if pruning has opened up dense plant. Grows 2-3' a year, for part shade-shade. Decorative orange-tan marks on brown bark. Z6 2-3' \$12

Syringa pekinensis China Snowtm	Rarely seen Peking Lilac Tree, this patented form from Chicago's botanic gardens has huge fragrant clusters of white bloom in June that form persistent tan fruit panicles which combine with peeling amber bark (like Acer griseum) for great winter appeal. Outstanding mid-sized tree with glossy green leaves for sun-part shade, drought and ice resistant. Z4 \$25
Taxodium ascendens Debonairtm	Native Pondcypress, delicate ferny foliage -28F \$30

MAGNOLIAS

ACUMINATA	Native cucumber magnolia gets its name from the shape of the fruits that develop from green to red. A magnificent large growing tree but rare. It is on the endangered list in Ontario. Does well in deep moist well drained slightly acid soils but does not tolerate extreme drought, wetness or pollution. -40 F \$12+
BUTTERFLIES tm	Small well-branched tree has abundant butter yellow spring bloom. Z6 \$2-3' \$45
GRANDIFLORA EDITH BOGUE	Evergreen magnolia native to Southeast US has 8" creamy white nutmeg- and lime-fragranced flowers summer through fall.. -10F \$45
MACROPHYLA VAR. ASHEI	A tropical looking magnolia with huge white blooms on young plants and extremely large leaves. As a native Carolinian understory tree it does well in shade. -10 F \$12 and up
SIEBOLDII 'COLOSSUS'	Oyama Magnolia is a superb small tree with peppermint-scented nodding white blooms with red stamens the end of May, good in semi-shaded areas in well-drained soil, species grows at the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum in a windy -30F. This cultivar is a precocious bloomer with colossal flowers and vigorous growth. 2-4' \$60-75
YELLOW BIRD	An acuminate var. subcordata cross with intense yellow flowers on a tall pyramidal tree -20F \$55
YELLOW LANTERN	An acuminate cross with creamy yellow tulip-like bloom before leaves emerge on vigorous tree, 18'X18' Z6 1qt \$25

ACTAEA 'BLACK NEGLIGEE'	2' high mound of lacy black foliage, purplish white flowers on 4' purple stalks smell of grapes and jasmine, most vigorous of dark Snakeroots, full sun gives darkest colour but part sun OK too Z6 \$20
ARMERIA 'RUBRIFOLIA'	Tight purple-leaved mound with deep pink flowers, for sun. \$8
ASTRANTIA 'HADSPEN BLOOD'	Red-flowered form of native Masterwort reblooms and has maroon tinged foliage as well. Needs sun to develop red colour. Z5 \$16
ATHYRIUM 'BURGUNDY LACE'	Reddest form of Japanese Painted Fern. Moist shade. \$12
ATHYRIUM SILVER FALLS	Especially silvery form of Japanese fern. Z5 \$10
BRUNNERA 'LOOKING GLASS'	White-leaved sport of Jack Frost glows in shady bed, Forget-Me-Not blue bloom. Z5 \$25
CAMPANULA PUNCTATA 'BOWL OF CHERRIES'	Dwarf of 'Cherry Bells' is a non-rampant groundcover form of Japanese bellflower, profuse fuchsia rebloomer. Z5 \$12
CAMPANULA ROYAL WAVE	Continuous 2" fragrant violet blue blooms with white eye on sturdy dense green 7" mound, for sun or part shade. Z5 \$16
CAMPANULA SARASTRO	Pint-sized version of Kent Belle is a groundcover for sun that sports extensive big purple bells on 18" well-branched stalks. Z6 \$12
CAMPANULA WARLEY'S WHITE	4" mound 1" white flower, good in troughs or sun, gravel. Z6 \$12
CAREX MOROWII 'ICE DANCE'	White-edged evergreen grass for (dry) shade 1'X3' Z6 \$10
CAREX OSHIMENSIS 'EVERGOLD'	Central gold stripe, compact 20" tuft. Z6B \$8

EMERALD TIARA	has green-edged yellow leaves that age to chartreuse and can really stand out if in good light. Purple flowers are held above a dense mound, serves as a specimen or ground cover.
ENGLISH SUNRISE	sport of June, bright golden leaves age to chartreuse, with good morning light its flowers are white
FRANCEE	large dark green heart-shaped leaves, clean white margin with some puckering on mature leaves, lavender flowers bloom in August above the 20" mound on this premier landscaping hosta
FRIED BANANAS	a sport of guacamole forming a medium large mound of gold leaves, fast growing and does well in some sun with near white fragrant flowers
FRIED GREEN TOMATOES	a large plant with near white fragrant blooms, sun tolerant, oval to heart shaped solid green leaves
GREEN FOUNTAIN	fountain-like mounding habit, lavender blooms with white cascade over shiny green oblong leaves
GINKO CRAIG	white variegated miniature groundcover
HALCYON	large heart-shaped powder-blue foliage - mauve flowers -15" x 28"
INNISGLOW	gold-leaved sport of Inniswood with heavily corrugated foliage forming a medium mound topped by lavender flowers in July
JUNE	lovely gold centered leaves with wide blue-green margins of heavy substance, pale bluish lavender flowers are held above a medium sized mound in late July \$12
KNOCKOUT	deep blue-green heart shaped leaves, wide cream edge of heavy substance, July blooms lavender
KROSSA REGAL	heavy leathery steel blue-grey leaves form vase shaped mound, lavender flowers 3' x 3'
LEMON LIME	dwarf chartreuse leaves, purple striped flowers, forms mound 18" x 12" ideal edger

LEOLA FRAIM	very attractive foliage with creamy margins that nicely contrast the dark green centre it is an ornamental equal to Patriot according to Zilis, a good ground cover or specimen plant
LOVE PAT	9" blue leaves heavily corrugated, slug resistant, large white blooms, med-large mound for back
MONTANA AUREOMARGINATA	graceful drooping, long pointed foliage with very wide bright yellow leaf margins that often streak into the green center of leaves of good substance, pale lavender flowers above vase-shaped plant
PATHFINDER	creamy white centre with dark green border, heavy slug resistant texture, wavy edge, nearly round leaf, flowers cream with purple spots
PEACE	cross from Love Pat it forms a medium sized mound of creamy yellow-margined leaves of thick substance and under bloom and flowers in June with near white flowers
SAGAE	large vase-shaped mound of creamy yellow-edged foliage sports 4' scapes of 3" lavender blooms of heavy texture, favourite of Japanese gardeners, 3'X6' mound a good focal point \$15
SEA THUNDER	medium mound of slightly wavy moderately corrugated leaves, green margin and center that ages from gold to creamy white, blooms are deep lavender, plant does best with morning sun
SEA OCTOPUS	dwarf with squiggly lance-shaped leaves
SECOND WIND	very dark green pointed slightly wavy leaves, pale violet flowers
SHADE FANFARE	light green leaves with wide cream margins, vigorous and showy lavender blooms
SIEBOLDIANA 'ELEGANS'	heavily corrugated blue foliage, dense white flower clusters, the standard of blue hosta, 3X6 \$15
SPRITZER	cascading mound of gold-centered, green margined foliage
STILLETTO	small narrow green lance-shaped leaves with a narrow wavy cream-coloured margin, good for edging or rock gardens

VENTRICOSA AUREOMARGINATA	a hosta "classic"of strikingly variegated foliage, grows well under a variety of conditions, irregular yellow margins turn white by early summer offsetting its bright purple late July blooms
